A Glimpse into the 4 Year Program:

1st Year:

Installation Practices, Math, Related Science, Blueprint Reading, Safety.

2nd Year:

Installation Practices, Math, Related Science, Blueprint Reading, Soldering, and Rigging.

3rd Year:

Installation Practices, Math, Gas Code, Related Science, and Blueprint Reading.

4th Year:

Installation Practices, Related Science, Math, Blueprint Reading, and Plumbing Code.

Class Requirements:

- 1) A minimum of 12 students will be required to hold a class. (If less than 12 students, class will be re-scheduled)
- 2) Student must be at least 18 years of age.
- 3) Student must have at least a 12th grade education with diploma or certified equivalency.
- 4) Student will have to be physically capable of performing the work of the trade with or without reasonable accommodations.
- 5) Student must earn a grade of "C" or better in all courses within the program, to receive certification of completion.
- 6) Payment In Full to Start Class - NO EXCEPTIONS.
